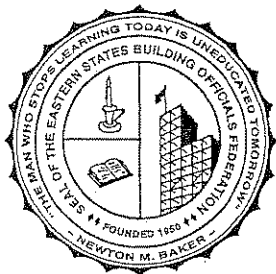

## Day One, Monday, March 28, 2011

### **A) *The Politics of Codes Instructor Ron Piester***

This course helps Code Officials to sharpen their political skills, covering the following topics:  
Assessing how politics (local, state and federal) are changing the way we do business.  
Navigating today's "system" and preparing for the politics of the future.  
Leveraging the politics of green and sustainable construction to support your department.  
Understanding the politics of code development.  
Keeping politics out of building safety.

### **B) *Construction in the Flood Plain Instructor Nick Agnoli-FEMA***

This conference presentation will cover the basics of determining the flood zone associated with a commercial, industrial or residential property, the impacts of the zone on permitted uses and construction methods, and methods of mitigating the impacts on a structure that has already been constructed in the zone. Additional topics will include modernization of the FEMA FIRMs, accessing the most current map and flood study information, and assisting property owners when the determination may be inaccurate. ### **A) *Chimneys and Vents Instructor Julius Ballanco***

This program reviews all the design, sizing, and installation requirements that have been updated in the IFGC, IMC and IBC. With the increased use of high efficiency gas fired equipment, the design of the chimney or vent becomes very critical. The resulting failure can leak carbon monoxide into the building.

The information will increase the participant's ability to locate, describe and apply the appropriate code sections of the IPMC in order to determine compliance or noncompliance while performing a residential or commercial inspection. 0.6 CEU's

### **B) *Decks Norman Hall-Simpson Strong Tie***

This seminar will be on the proper construction of decks and the correct connectors in order to meet the current building codes. Codes that are referred to are the 2006-2009 International codes. This seminar is appropriate for deck builders, home inspectors and building officials.

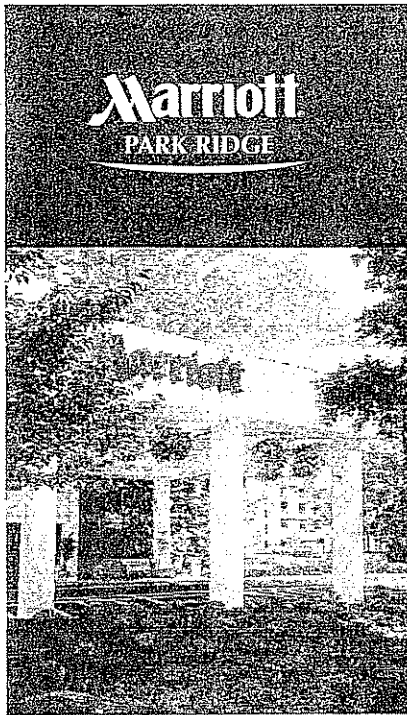

**FROM NEWARK AIRPORT:** Take the New Jersey Turnpike North to Route 80 West, follow Route 80 West to the Saddle Brook Exit for the Garden State Parkway North to Exit 172, then follow from above directions.

**FROM NEW YORK CITY:** Take the George Washington Bridge West to New Jersey. Follow to Route 80 West. Take Route 80 West to the Saddle Brook Exit for the Garden State Parkway. Follow the Garden State Parkway North to Exit 172, and follow directions from above.

**FROM LAGUARDIA AIRPORT:** Take the Grand Central Parkway to the Tri-Borough Bridge to the Major Deegan Expressway to I-95 West to the George Washington Bridge. Follow directions from New York City.

**FROM KENNEDY AIRPORT:** Leaving the airport via the Van Wyck Expressway to the Grand Central Parkway. Follow directions from LaGuardia Airport.

**FROM UPSTATE NEW YORK:** New York State Thruway to Exit 14A onto the Garden State Parkway Extension. Take first exit "Chestnut Ridge." From ramp make left onto Schoolhouse Road. Follow through first light (Summit Avenue), road becomes Spring Valley Road, follow through second light (Grand Avenue) to fourth (4th) right, Brae Blvd., make right onto Brae Blvd., hotel is approximately 1/4 mile on right hand side.

**FROM NEW ENGLAND AND WESTCHESTER:** Via the Connecticut Turnpike/New England Thruway, (I-95), to the Cross Westchester Expressway (I-287) to the Tappan Zee Bridge West, proceed across Bridge to New York State Thruway North, to exit 14A. Follow directions from Upstate New York.

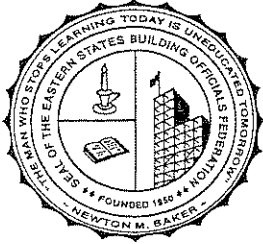
